Whole School Impact

- Central Primary is in the top 40% of schools for value added with PPG pupils achieving 100.3 showing that they are progressing faster than average
- Our results for PPG children at KS2 have improved significantly in the past year as a result of the intervention (42% increase in Level 4+ Reading; 55% increase in Level 4+ Writing)
- 78% of PPG pupils attained Level 4 in Reading, Writing and Maths which is above the national average of 69%
- PPG children are making strong progress overtime within the school
