Impact on Attainment:

- *Pupils in receipt of pupil premium are making good and better progress (Reading 4.8/ Writing 4.6 and Maths 4.8) this is in line with all other pupils in the school (2012 – 2013) This has been sustained into this year Reading 3.2 Writing 2.7 and Maths 2.4 this is in line with other groups (March 2014).*
- *Pupils in Y5/ Y6 are making even better progress and benefit from the smaller teaching groups part funded by pupil premium*
- *Booster groups are supporting pupil premium children as are additional adults in classrooms*
- *100% of Y6 Pupils in receipt of pupils premium are expected to make 2 levels progress across KS2*
