



Central Primary Curriculum Overview – Year 4 – Summer Term (2)

Subject Area	Content
English	<p>Reading: Independent reading will happen every day, every child will read with an adult at least three times a week and some children read with an adult every day. Additionally small groups will have a structured guided reading session with the teacher once a week.</p> <p>Speaking and Listening: The children will be learning to tell stories effectively, through the use of drama and role-play. Development of speaking and listening skills are encouraged and applied across the curriculum, in all subject areas.</p> <p>Writing: The children will be focusing on creating and shaping texts, text structure and organisation and presentation. Looking specifically this half term at biographies (link to our Art and History and Geography topics) and stories.</p>
Maths	<p>We will be consolidating the following areas in maths:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Addition • Subtraction • Units of measurement. • <p>During our mental oral starters we will work on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Word problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. • Data handling • Angles
Science	<p>Scientific Investigations Skills: During this summer term we will review and consolidate the concepts that we have been learning all year in our different topics throughout investigations. We will be learning to ask questions that can be investigated scientifically and decide how to find answers. We will be learning to think about what might happen (predicting) and suggest ways to collect and record data.</p>
ICT	<p>Linked to our English and Topic work, the children will use computers to work on creating and shaping texts, organisation and presentation of a biography. They will also show the different types of printing and how they have changed over time. We will look at the different features that can be used to create and personalise a text in a word document. Both of these creations will be displayed in our class museum along with our art work.</p>
Topic ‘Night at the museum’	<p>As part of a whole school project, children will be working towards creating their own museum in their classrooms.</p> <p>Art: In Art, we will be looking at Scandinavian patterns. Focussing on Marimekko an influential textile design company known for their bold colours and prints inspired by nature.</p> <p>History: “History of printing” will be the topic on this subject. The children will be exposed at different models of printing that were created hundreds of years ago and how they changed over time since their invention. The will also think about the reasons behind the necessity and development of printing.</p> <p>Geography: Year four will see where printing was originated and developed around the world.</p>
Music	<p>We will be continuing following the voices foundation scheme of work. Starting with Unit 13 and 14 which includes consolidating concepts like phrase, tempo, pitch and rhythm.</p>

P.E.	In PE, we will start a new programme called "Move and Lean". The focus is healthy lifestyles, nutrition, exercise and the body. There will be a theory side done in the classroom with interactive handsets and then a practical session. Over the six weeks, the children will do 3 different sports: Football, handball and dodgeball.
PSHCE	In PSHE, we will be exploring 'Changes', exploring in particular the emotions that we experience about changes that we cannot control, and how this affects the behaviour of ourselves and others.
French	In French this half term we are exploring the local area, and planning journeys. We will study directional language, names for place in town and start to expand our use of verbs.
R.E.	In Religious Education, this time, the focus will be special books and sacred writing and stories: Bible (Christianity), Guru Granth Sahib (Sikhism) and Bhagavad Gita (Hinduism).
