English	Guided Reading	Maths
<p>In English, we will be studying the following text types:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Instructions● Traditional tales● Shape poems <p>For each text type we will; examine key vocabulary, look at the structure of the text, pick one or two grammar features to learn about, gather our own ideas, plan our writing and edit it.</p> <p>We will continue to focus on writing multi-clause sentences using a wider range of conjunctions including; and, or, but, so, when, if, that and because. Shape coding will be used to help us structure our writing.</p> <p>On a daily basis, we will remind ourselves about capital letters and full stops. We will also develop the use of further punctuation according to our prior knowledge and individual strengths. This will include; question marks, exclamation marks, commas, colons, apostrophes and speech marks.</p>	<p>We will continue to have structured Guided Reading sessions every day.</p> <p>During these sessions we will explore a range of fiction and non-fiction texts. We will be developing our fluency skills using both choral and echo reading, alongside independent reading.</p> <p>We will also focus on developing the following comprehension skills:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Vocabulary● Retrieval● Inference● Summarising● Predicting <p>In addition to this, all pupils will read their reading book (from the coloured bands) on a one to one basis with an adult at least three times a week. Reading books will be changed on a weekly basis.</p>	<p>In Maths this half term we will be developing our knowledge of two further operations before moving on to other areas.</p> <p>The following areas will be explored in varying depth and breadth according to our prior knowledge:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Multiplication● Division● Fractions● Position and direction <p>We will continue to use concrete resources and pictorial representations to support our understanding of these topics.</p> <p>In addition to this, all pupils will work on a personalised programme of times tables at least three times a week in order to develop their recall of key facts.</p>
