<p>This term we will exploring:</p> <p>Recount (Biography): The children will explore biographies using a model text about Frida Khalo before writing their own biography about the life of Muhammad Ghandi.</p> <p>Poetry: Building on their knowledge of Haiku, the children will look at <i>Tanka</i> poems with a nature theme this half term. The focus will be on the structure.</p>	<p>Independent reading will happen every day and some children will read with an adult every day. Additionally the class will have a structured guided reading session with the teacher daily where children will work on the reading skills (comprehension, retrieving, summarising, vocabulary).</p> <p>This half term we will be reading 'The Pebble in my Pocket: A History of our Earth' by Meredith Hooper.</p>	<p>We will be looking at the following areas:</p> <p>Multiplication and Division: The children will consolidate their learning of the 2, 4 and 8 times table. They will then use a range of strategies to multiply and divide 2 digits by 1 digit.</p> <p>Measurement (Money): Children will be introduced to the £ and p sign for the first time. They will count in 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins. Students can also use related facts to count in 20p coins.</p>	<p>This half term, we will be exploring Animals including humans. The children will explore nutrition</p>

<p>This half term, we will be doing History. Our topic is 'Ancient Egypt'</p> <p>The children will look at a range of sources and use them to infer how Egyptians lived their life in Ancient Egypt. They will further look at some of the achievements of Ancient Egypt and compare it to another historical period.</p>	<p>This half term, Year 3 will look at E-safety. Students will identify inappropriate/ appropriate content and what to do if they come across dangerous behaviours online. They will also explain how they can stay safe online and apply their learning by producing an E-Safety poster.</p>	<p>This term, the children will be looking at prayer and worship. They will look at the Lord's Prayer and explain the key messages alongside how some Christians might adhere to it.</p> <p>Students will further look at the 5 pillars of Islam. They will focus on two of the pillars (Sawm and Salah) and how Muslims adhere to it, in addition to how it might make them feel.</p>	<p>Our unit this half term will be 'Dreams and goals'. The children will identify their own dreams and goals. They will come up with strategies to cope with disappointment and make new plans and goals when they have been disappointed. They will also work in groups to achieve a goal and identify everyone's contribution to the group's achievement.</p>
